## INVITATION TO BID

1. The Philippine National Police, with the National Expenditure Program of 2018 as basis, intends to apply the sum of **Two Hundred Eighty-One Million Pesos [Php281,000,000.00]** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **10,000 units Striker Fired 9mm Pistol (Lot 2)** under **Public Bidding No. PNP-17-72G**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Philippine National Police now invites bids for the aforementioned project. Delivery of the Goods shall be divided into three tranches, to wit:

Tranches	Units	Delivery Period	Total Number of Days
1 <sup>st</sup> Tranche	2,000	The Delivery of Goods shall be within <b>90 calendar days from receipt of the Notice to Proceed.</b>	180 calendar days
2 <sup>nd</sup> Tranche	4,000	Within <b>60 calendar days</b> from the last day of the 1 <sup>st</sup> tranche.	
3 <sup>rd</sup> Tranche	4,000	Within <b>30 calendar days</b> from the last day of the 2 <sup>nd</sup> tranche.	
<b>Total</b>	<b>10,000</b>		

Bidders should have completed, **within five (5) years prior to the date of submission and receipt of their bids**, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained also in the Bidding Documents, particularly in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Philippine National Police and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during working days from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders from **December 9, 2017 to January 11, 2018** from the address below upon payment of a nonrefundable fee amounting to **Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php50,000.00)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The Philippine National Police will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on December 19, 2017 at 9:00AM** at the PNP Main Conference Room, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor PNP NHQ Building, Camp BGen Rafael T Crame, Quezon City, which shall be open to all prospective bidders.
6. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before **January 11, 2018 at 9:00AM**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause 18**.

Bid opening shall be on **January 11, 2018** at exactly **9:00AM** at the **PNP Main Conference Room, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor PNP NHQ Building, Camp BGen Rafael T Crame, Quezon City**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

7. Please be reminded that the GPPB issued Circular No. 07-2017 dated July 31, 2017 entitled "Deferment of the Implementation of the Mandatory Submission of PHILGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership" hence, prospective bidders are required to submit the following Class "A" eligibility documents under Sections 23.1(a) and 24.1(a) of the IRR of RA No. 9184, to wit:
  - a. Registration Certificate;
  - b. Mayor's/Business Permit or its equivalent document;
  - c. Tax Clearance; and
  - d. Audited Financial Statements.

In lieu of the above documents, prospective may still submit their PhilGeps Platinum Certificate of Registration and Membership at their option.

8. The Philippine National Police reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
