

PNP OPERATIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

3rd Quarter 2021

Amidst the continuing situation of the country in facing the worldwide pandemic of COVID 19 outbreak, the Philippine National Police is relentless in maintaining peace and order, extending every possible assistance to the community and assists the local government in the delivery of much needed government services.

The PNP leadership continuously endeavors to maintain its police force that is highly capable, effective and credible to be able serve every Filipino, and maintain our country to be peaceful, secure, free of illegal drugs and corruption and progressive.

The PNP promotes "BAYANIHAN SPIRIT" and the "Community Service Oriented Policing (CSOP) for stronger partnership and active engagement with communities in ensuring peace and order and addressing criminality giving priority on the campaign against illegal drugs, illegal gambling and other focus crimes; anti-violent extremism/terrorism; internal security operations (ISO); and maximizing police visibility in areas to sustain the gains against crime and violence.

Regular Law Enforcement

Police Presence. Intensified police presence were sustained wherein a total of 8,870,982 foot/beat and mobile patrol operations were conducted with 76,852,711 man-hours of foot/beat patrols and 27,785,376 man-hours of mobile patrols were spent. Additionally, several Quarantine Control Points (QCPs) and Dedicated Control Points (DCPs) were established in relation to COVID-19 operations. A total of 10,099 PNP personnel were deployed in relation to COVID-19. On the implementation of local ordinances (i.e. drinking in public, smoking ban, half-naked in public, curfew and others), a total of 3,631,967 violators were apprehended.

Focused Law Enforcement. Aggressive police operations and other police interventions led to the arrest of lawless elements that somehow reduced the number of crimes that they may have committed.

Campaign against Illegal Drugs. For the period, there were 214 drug personalities surrendered to police stations nationwide. Meanwhile, Police operations against illegal drugs resulted in the arrest of 16,051 drug personalities and the confiscation of illegal drugs with an estimated DDB value of more than PhP1.709Billion, Additionally, in joint operations with PDEA, more than PhP5.858 Billion worth of illegal drugs were confiscated.
